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Cloud Shape Dimensions with

#8 US Knitting Needle & Worsted Weight Yarn:

Small Cloud 6" wide by 4.5" tall, approximately
Large Cloud 9.5" wide by 5.5" tall, approximately

Materials

Yarn, in any weight / color of your choice
Straight Knitting Needles, sized for your yarn
Tapestry Needle; Scissors

Abbreviations

BO: Bind Off CO: Cast On, Long-Tail K: Knit
CCO: Cast On, Cable Method (*increases*)
K1M1: Knit One, Make One (*increases*)
K2Tog: Knit 2 Together (*decreases*)
SLKPSSO: Slip Knit Pass One Stitch Over (*decreases*)

Using #8 US Knitting Needle & Worsted Weight Yarn:
9.5" wide by 5.5" tall, approximately

Knitting from the bottom up, we begin by making the lower left cloud curve.

Knitting from the bottom up, we begin by making the lower left cloud curve.
